

INFORMATION NEEDED TO CONDUCT DISEASE INVESTIGATIONS

DISEASE	INFORMATION REQUIRED TO REPORT A CASE
COCCIDIODOMYCOSIS	Fungal cultures and all other final lab results History and physical Discharge summary MD notes Infectious Disease Consults Chest x-ray Bronchoscopy results (if done)
ENTERIC DISEASES (Amebiasis) (Salmonellosis) (Shigellosis) (Hepatitis A) (E. Coli 0157)	Lab with positive result* (final preferred) History and physical Discharge Summary * For Hepatitis A, need to include IgM lab result.
ENCEPHALITIS MENINGITIS	Specify etiology Final CSF results (Bacterial, fungal, viral) Serum WNV History and physical
HEPATITIS B	Lab result: positive hepatitis B results, LFT's Acute or chronic Pregnant (If yes, report EDC) History and physical Discharge summary
LYME DISEASE	Lab result - Must have Western Blot with 3 positive bands Erythema migrans History and physical Discharge summary
LEGIONELLA	LAB result - Urine Antigen Positive Four fold rise in antibody titer or (Culture Positive or DFA positive of one of the following: lung biopsy, respiratory secretions, pleural fluid or blood) History and physical Discharge summary Pneumonia, X-ray diagnosed Travel or stay overnight somewhere other than usual residence
PERTUSSIS	Lab result History and physical MD notes Vaccination records
Q FEVER	History and physical Discharge summary Chest x-ray Lab results: Fourfold or greater change in antibody titer to <i>C. burnetii</i> phase II or phase I antigen in paired serum specimens ideally taken 3-6 weeks apart, or, Isolation of <i>C. burnetii</i> from a clinical specimen by culture, or Demonstration of <i>C. burnetii</i> in a clinical specimen by detection of antigen or nucleic acid.
